

Technology Certificate Programs

For students interested in the growing field of technology and learning, Drake's Adult Learning and Organizational Performance (ALOP) program has a partnership with two technology certificate programs. Students can attend online classes to earn a certificate in Instructional Systems Technology (Indiana University, 15 credits) or in Designing eLearning Environments (University of Colorado, 18 credits) and can transfer up to 12 credits from these certificate programs into the ALOP program to satisfy as much as one-third of the 36 credit hours required for the master's in ALPD!

Indiana University (Bloomington) Certificate in Instructional Systems Technology (<http://www.indiana.edu/~istde/>)

A student must complete 5 courses (15 credit hours) to fulfill the requirements of the IST Certificate program, including 4 required courses and 1 elective course.

Required courses for the certificate program:

- R511: Instructional Technology Foundations (3 credits)
- R521: Instructional Design & Development (3 credits)
- R561: Evaluation & Change in the Instructional Design Process (3 credits)

And one of the following production courses (based on prior production experience)

- R541: Instructional Design & Production Process I (R521 prerequisite or equivalent experience)
- R547: Computer mediated Learning (R541 prerequisite or equivalent experience)

Elective courses for the certificate program:

Students must complete one elective from the following list:

- R519: Effective Writing for Instructional Technology
- R547: Computer Mediated Learning (R541 prerequisite or equivalent experience)
- R626: Instructional Strategies and Tactics (R521 prerequisite)
